♦ Those in district who purchase Apps and books
♦ Redeem Volume Vouchers in the Volume Purchase Education Store
♦ They can search for Apps
♦ At WHRHS these are Supervisors and Directors (content folks)

The PF redeems the Volume Voucher at the Volume Purchase Education Store, thus creating an account that can be drawn upon

Money is in perpetuity

WHRHS suggest \$100 redemption at a time

Breaking Down the Brick Wall of Volume Purchasing and BYOD

Model: Desktop Virtualization (VDI)

Advantages:

- 1) Takes away the need for a physical computer for each student to be bought by the district.
- 2) Compatible with devices that our students own already.
- 3) Thin Clients- dummy terminal, POE.
- 4) Links to Rubicon Atlas in the future.
- 5) Push out course curriculum onto the Desktop of students.
- 6) Less maintenance for IT department.
