#### Village School Gym Update

As most of you are already aware, our gym floor was damaged beyond repair when a pipe burst during one of the extremely cold nights we experienced this winter. As a result, out PE teachers have been most creative and flexible, holding classes in the cafeteria, front foyer, as well as outside, weather permitting. Our district business office, under the direction of Tom Venanzi, responded quickly to this emergency by procuring the approvals necessary to get a new floor installed. Thanks to their diligence, the damaged gym floor is now almost completely removed, and the installation process will likely begin next week. We hope to have a new floor installed and ready for use in May, if everything goes well. We have moved one assembly to OHES, and will keep you informed if any of our other school events or activities need to be relocated. Thank you for your flexibility and understanding.

#### PARCC and NJ ASK Updates

Our first-ever administration of the new PARCC assessments has gone very smoothly, owing to the district PARCC Team's extensive preparation on both the academic and technology fronts. Due to inclement weather, the spring performance-based assessments will be completed on April 1st. You received the amended schedule in a previous e-blast.

The PARCC end-of-year assessments (three days instead of five) will be administered from April 27th through May 22nd. We will provide you with a detailed schedule after spring break. Fourth grade students are still required to take the NJ ASK Science assessment. This will be administered on May 27th, with makeups being given on May 28th. Here again is the revised PARCC PBA schedule.

<u>Third Grade Classes from Week 1</u> will take their 3 make up tests (1 LA and 2 Math) on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, March 23-25. These classes are Sears/Carro, Cramer, Ryan, Bonnet/Furfaro, Vucin, Damato, Gluck, Uhaze/Loiacono, B. Rodriguez, and Potter/Brown.

<u>Students in both grades</u> will take any remaining makeups according to the following schedule: LA Unit 1 - 3/26, LA Unit 2 - 3/27, LA Unit 3 - 3/30, Math Unit 1 - 3/31, Math Unit 2 - 4/1.

These are the only days that these makeup tests will be given.
