



- The "Well-Lopsided Student" students who show a long-term commitment (similarly in sports) and focus.
- Common Application Supplements even if not majoring in music, some schools offer scholarships and benefits to gifted non-music majors... often when attending a school where music is not what they're primarily known for.
- AP's, SAT's, ACT's are a portion of the portfolio. Interviews are increasingly prevalent and social skills are important; interviewers want to envision potential students fitting into their institution's fabric.
