2022-23 SENIOR YEAR COURSE SELECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- Register for at least 30 credits Study Hall/Early Dismissal will be added by your counselor.
- Required Courses: English 12 (AP, Honors, CP) AND Health/PE
- Select an additional 20-25 credits made up of the following optional subjects
 - Social Studies, Math, Science, World, Languages, Career Exploration, Visual & Performing Arts
- When requesting elective courses in Social Studies, Career Exploration and Visual Performing Arts, you must request a backup or alternate course.
 - For example, if you wish to take Sociology and Photography, you must request either two more 2.5 credit courses or one 5 credit course as a backup. You can pick them from any subject area, backup courses don't have to be the same subject as your first choice (for example, to backup Sociology you could choose Game Design).
 - You'll rank their priority from 1-4 in the drop-down menu next to the course. This
 means that you may end up requesting up to 45 credits, that's OK, your counselor will
 discuss your options when you meet.
 - If this is not done, your counselor may have to choose an elective for you based on availability – make sure this doesn't have to happen, choose them now.
- Important information regarding course placement
 - For now, course requests will be based on your semester grades. Use the <u>MHS Program</u>
 of Studies (2022-23) to determine which courses are appropriate for you.
 - o If you wish to take a course that you currently do not meet the pre-requisite for, <u>request</u> the course you qualify for now. When you meet with your counselor, tell him/her which course you would like and if you meet the pre-requisite at the mid-point of semester 2, he/she will make the change in your requests.
 - If at the midpoint of semester 2 you still do not meet the pre-requisite, there will be an option to request a placement waiver. Waivers can be obtained from your teacher and must be handed in to your teacher by April 29, 2022.
