

Physical Education Grading Policy 2022 - 2023

7th and 8th Grade

Preparation = 30%

Students must be in appropriate attire for physical activity. This includes a shirt and shorts/pants that are in regulation with the school dress code. Please keep in mind that you will be MOVING in our class; you are not sitting at a desk. So, clothing that is appropriate for other classes might NOT be appropriate for PE class. (For example, a shirt that covers your mid section while seated might not cover your mid section if you were to raise your arms above your head). Shoes must be fit for running, with laces, and rubber soles. Students do NOT need to change their clothes when they are in health.

- ❖ If a student fails to tell their attendance teacher that he/she is unprepared, this may result in double the amount of points lost. A student MUST change BOTH their shirt and pants/shorts, and be in appropriate shoes in order to receive credit for preparation.

1st Unprepared = loss of 30%, but can still participate if dressed appropriately

2nd Unprepared = loss of 30%, but can still participate if dressed appropriately

3rd and 4th Unprepared = loss of 100%, but can still participate if dressed appropriately (email will be sent to parent/guardian)

5th Unprepared or more = loss of 100%, cannot participate in class, and must complete alternate assignment

Behavior, Effort, and Participation = 40%

Students must be actively listening (remain focused and attentive) during instructions, so that they will be able to follow those instructions during the activity, and ensure the safety of everyone involved.

Students must keep their hands and feet to themselves, unless participating in an activity where it would be necessary.

Students must be actively engaged and give maximum effort throughout the entire class period.

Sportsmanship and Teamwork = 30%

Students must be respectful towards themselves, their peers, the teacher(s), and the equipment.

Students must work cooperatively with partners and/or teammates.

Students must use appropriate language at all times.

Students must follow rules, demonstrate fairness, and provide encouragement to their peers.
