ID Cards

To further enhance our safety and security procedures, we have updated our student identification card rules district-wide. Each school has sent out information this month regarding how ID cards will be used in their buildings, and they have also included a section in their respective student handbooks about ID cards.

Universally, please remember that all students must wear their school-issued ID card and lanyard at all times on the exterior of their clothing from the moment they enter the bus and/or walk into their school building. Students must have their ID when attending school-related events (both after school and on weekends) and may be subject to disciplinary consequences if they do not wear or present their ID card. If a student loses their ID card or lanyard, they will be charged a \$5 replacement fee that must be paid through your PaySchools account.

PaySchools

The district will continue to use PaySchools, a streamlined payment system, this school year. All school-related payments, such as cafeteria funds, ID card replacement fees, and more will be collected through PaySchools. New this school year, any lunch account that falls below a -\$10.00 balance will prohibit a student from purchasing lunch. Please check your PaySchools account before the start of school to avoid any interruption.
