We are utilizing an electronic course request system. As a result, current 6th grade students/parents will be able to log onto Parent Resources and choose their electives using the following instructions:

How to Request Your Electives and World Language Courses:

1. Go To: Parent Resources
2. Go To: Scheduling Tab
3. Go To: Request Tab
4. Go To: Request a Course (center of screen)
5. Select Green button to "Request This Course"

Current 6th Grade Students

1. If you choose band, chorus, or orchestra, DO NOT choose any other electives. These are full year courses.
2. Otherwise, choose any **four** of the remaining semester elective course options.
3. Out of these four, we will do our best to schedule you for **two** of your choices (one each semester).
4. Choose German part 1, French part 1, or Spanish part 1.

The window for course selection will open for students on Tuesday, March 12th, and end on Friday, March 22nd. Students who do not register for electives or a world language (incoming 7th graders only) within this time frame will be randomly placed in courses. Please contact your guidance counselor if you do not have access and need to fill out a paper copy of the student "Course Selection" form.
