Board of Education Report - Cookie Franco-Herman

 - They are dealing with labor shortages and supply chain issues
 - Action Plan has been put in place to see improvements over the next few months
 - Looking for parent volunteers to join an ad-hoc committee to look at food services
 - In process of being put together now
 - Would like 2 parents from each school
 - Meet ~2 times per month Jan through Mar
 - Expect meeting to not be more than one hour
- Chartwells accepting applications to volunteer in the kitchens or for employment
 - Will pay for training
 - Can contact Cookie if interested
- Is there any food prep that can happen after school hours the day before and have the HS students do it for their community service hours?
 - Not sure, Cookie to ask
- Don't MTSD employ kitchen staff directly rather than through Chartwells?
 - We don't but will ask. Think it is a budget issue
