They provide research based articles to promote high quality education. One of their articles discusses the importance of science within the classroom and the top 10 ways to support science learning. Here are their top 10 ways:

1. Value your child's questions.

- 2. Explore and find the answers together.
- 3. Give children time and space to explore.
- 4. Accept that explorations are often messy.
- 5. Learn from mistakes together.
- 6. Invite curiosity.
- Support further exploration.

Encourage children to record their observations.

- 9. Make good use of your electronic devices
- 10. Use items you have at home to experiment and explore
