

SCISSOR PRACTICE AT HOME




One of the skills that we have been practicing on at school is cutting. I know this can be scary when you let your little one had scissors at home...but with supervised instruction and trust you will be amazed at how well your child can cut independently!

One of the modifications we make for our students is to place a smiley face stick on the thumb section of the scissor. So, instead of just reminding them to keep their "thumb up!" we can say "Smiley face up!" A fun little trick to remind them that their thumb needs to face up as they cut.
