





What <u>Six</u> Elements Make a Society "Civilized"?














A society is civilized when it has...

- ⋄ a religious belief system.

Why Do Civilizations Rise and Decline?























Civilizations rise and decline when...

- RISE- people have access to resources such as food, water, materials for clothing, building materials, and energy resources (oil, coal, etc.). Civilizations also rise when they have a strong government and wealthy economy.
- DECLINE- people are at war with one another or other nations, natural disasters/catastrophes occur, governments fail, or the economy is weak.


