## Primary Source

- □ First person accounts that are recorded at the time of an event
- □ Offer an inside view of a particular event

### Examples

- Original works in various media formats such as:
- Photographs
- Drawings
- Letters
- Diaries
- Documents

- □ Books
- □ Films
- □ Posters
- □ Play Scripts
- □ Speeches
- □ Songs
- □ Sheet Music

## Secondary Source

Source created by someone either not present when the event took place or removed by time from the event

### Examples

- □ Textbooks
- □ Journal Articles
- Websites
- □ Magazine Articles
