



Read 19.6, Print out, read, annotate Pres. McKinley's "War Message" (questions will be completed in class); **DQ #2** due in class with annotated notes. Receive roles for imperialism debate (Process: 2; Skill 1-4)

# NEW REGISTRATION PROCESS/ASSESSMENT

- All students in this class must register at <u>https://user.totalregistration.net/AP/311359</u>.
- This is the first step in joining the AP classroom for this course as well as signing up for the exam if your child is planning to take it.
- Even if your child is not taking the exam, you must go through the Total Registration process
- You will have the option to indicate that your child is not taking the exam.
- Your child will be able to change their exam decision without penalty until October 31st.

## May 2022 Exam Results

45 Montgomery HS students took the exam

Average was 4.38

- 27 earned 5s (60%)
  10 earned 4s (22%)
  6 earned 3s (13%)
  2 earned 2s (4%)
- 0 earned 1s ( 0%)
- 95.6% passing rate rate

Only 11%- 5s 16% - 4s 22% - 3s 23% - 2s 29% - 1s 48.2% passing
