Why should I volunteer at Stonebridge?

- Stonebridge is a local independent and assisted living facility, conveniently located at Hollinshead Spring Road in Skillman.
- Very few kids volunteer at Stonebridge and the elderly residents LOVE to have younger people visit! Girls and boys are both welcome to volunteer!
- There is no age requirement but those under 18 are advised to go with an adult.
- Over the years, the Girl Scouts in Montgomery have established a connection with the Recreation Director at Stonebridge, Angela Santos. You don't need to be a Girl/Boy Scout to volunteer, though!
- You can volunteer alone, with friends, with a club you belong to, or with family.
- Hours and days are flexible – volunteer as much as you want, or as little as you want. Volunteer during the day, evenings, weekdays, or weekends! Volunteer for 30 minutes, or for 3 hours!
